Intellectual property matters

Tim has represented both former employers as plaintiffs and departing employees as defendants in cases involving employee departures. These cases usually involve claims under covenants not to compete as well as claims for theft of trade secrets. His work has included bringing or defending preliminary injunctions and handling temporary restraining order hearings in federal and state courts.

Select representations include:

- Persuaded a Delaware County Court not to preliminarily enjoin an employee from working at a competitor even though the court found that there was an enforceable covenant not to compete on the grounds that the plaintiff had made an inadequate showing of immediate irreparable harm
